# 2013 FLAG CITY QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

To assure equitable classification and handicapping, a specific number of targets must have been shot in 2012 and 2013 combined, with a certain minimum of them in 2013.

	<b>Total 2012-2013</b>	<b>Minimum in 2013</b>	<b>Class/Yardage Minimum</b>
16 Yards	800	400	Class A
Handicap	800	400	*
Doubles	400	200	Class B

\*Penalty – no less than 2 yards added to current yardage.

In case of Women and Sub-Juniors the minimum will be B and C respectively. **Penalty yardage will be waived for Sr. Veterans.**

### Event #7

The **Browning Gun Company** will be presenting a **BT-99** to the Winner of this event.

- [1] Individuals must be classified according to the rules for this particular weekend.
- [2] Upon completion of this event, a representative from Browning will randomly select **TWO** numbers from zero to nine.
- [3] Individuals with a score ending in the numbers selected will be eligible to shoot-off for the shotgun. For example: if the numbers 4 is drawn, **ALL** scores ending in a 4 are eligible to compete in the shoot-off.
- [4] Shoot-off participants will then proceed to shoot two (2) targets at each post for a total of ten (10) targets from their ATA yardage.
- [5] All shoot-off rounds will consist of ten (10) target events; shoot-offs will continue until a single winner has been determined.
- [6] Shooters with the high score in this event will **NOT** be eligible to win the shotgun IF that is the number drawn. For example: if the high score is 98, and "8" is the number drawn, the 98's may not shoot for the shotgun.
